



Can other family and friends contribute?


This tax credit is available to all Arizona taxpayers regardless of whether or not they have children in school.



- If I want to chaperone, do I have to pay? Yes.
 Am I able to follow the bus in my car?No.
 What happens if my child gets sick or injured?
 *car sickness Your student will be cared for by a fourth grade teacher (we do not have our own groups. We will call home and communicate with you what happened.)
- Is my money refundable? No.
- What if I don't have the \$185 right away? You can pay in increments as long as it is paid by March 2nd in full.
- How many children will be going? Generally speaking, about 60 or so students attend the trip.
