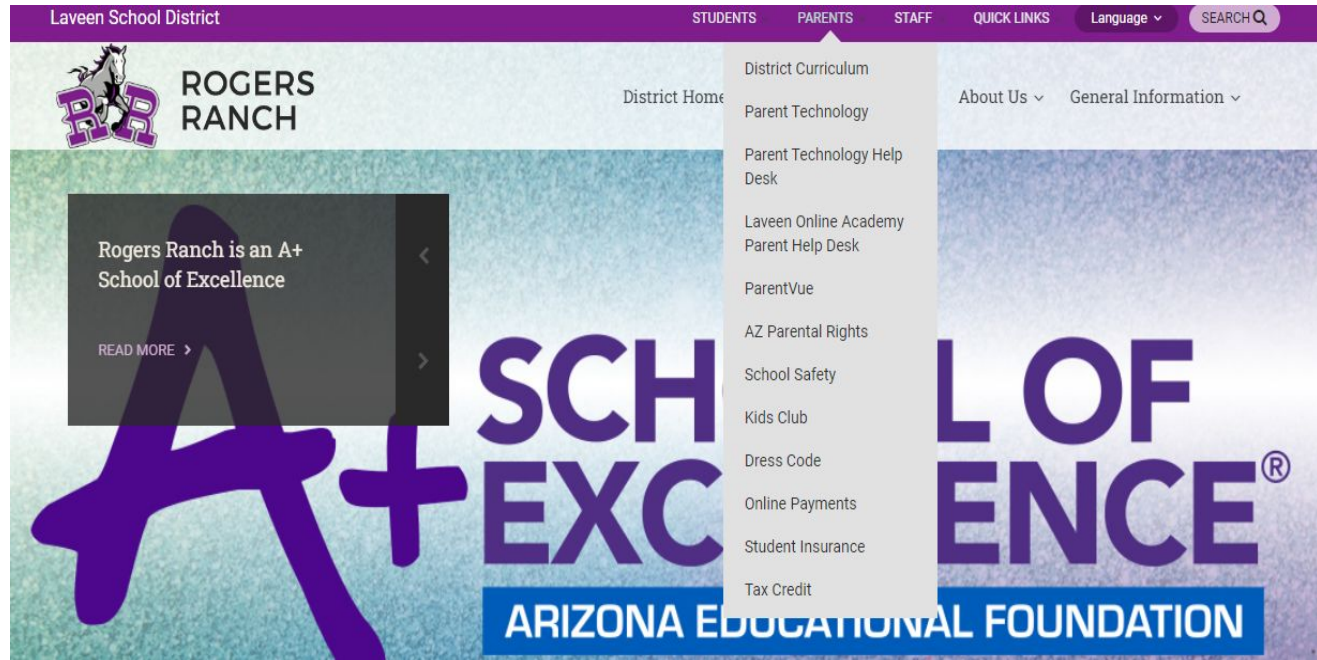

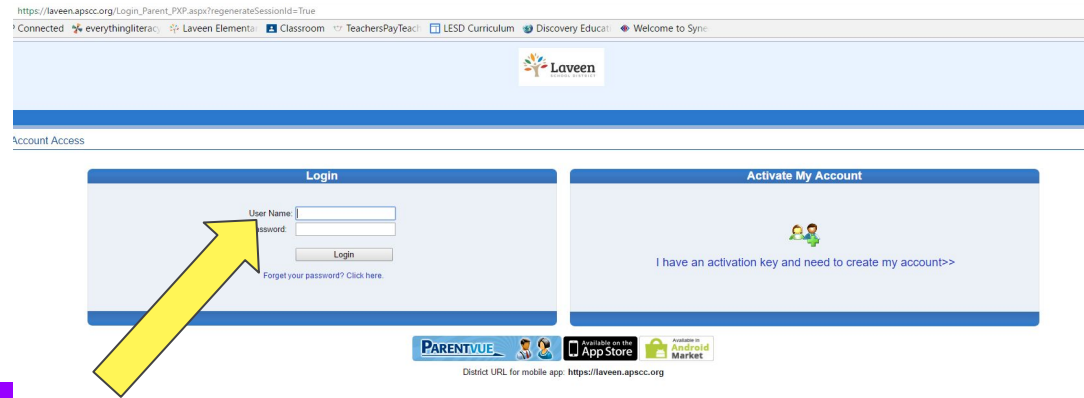
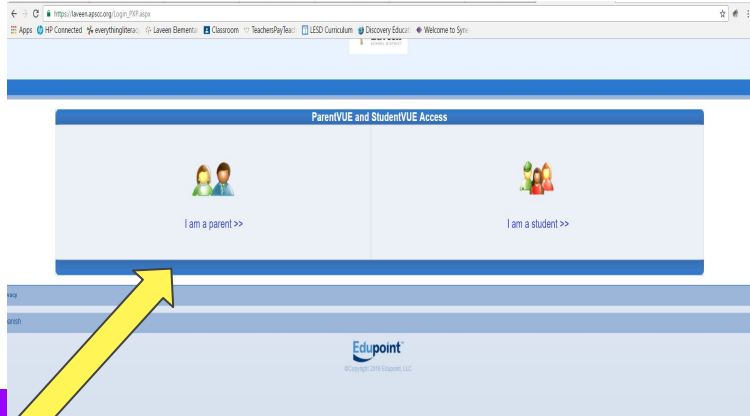

WHAT IS STANDARDS BASED GRADING?

Standard-based grading is a system which allows us to better communicate with parents on the progress students are making toward mastering the content standards adopted by the State of Arizona.

STANDARDS BASED GRADING

ACADEMIC GRADE

The academic grades will only include assignments or tests that measure the students' mastery of the learning standards. These grades will reflect each student's individual understanding of the academic content.



EFFORT GRADE

The effort grades will include such things as class assignments, homework, and participation. These factors are important to help ensure student learning, but separating them from the achievement grade will give parents a clearer picture about what each student's level of mastery is regarding the state academic standards.
